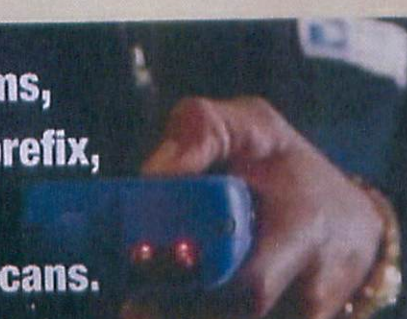


International Scanning

ALL international item bar-codes from A to Z must be scanned. If you see multiple barcodes or have any doubts, scan ALL barcodes on every international item you deliver.
